

Certificate of Advanced Study: e-Government Management and Leadership 2017- 2018 Advising Check Sheet

Co-administered by the School of Information Studies and the Maxwell School, the 12-credit-e-Gov curriculum includes a 6-credit primary core and 6-credits of electives. It is designed to prepare students to lead and manage e-government applications in complex public and private sector organizations.
